## Success in 3rd May Elections

I am pleased to announce that in the May 3rd Elections, I was re-elected onto the Easton-in-Gordano Parish Council. And would like to thank the electors in the Pill Ward who voted for me.

Back in July 2006, I expressed my interest in joining the council, along with one other applicant, as there were two vacancies. We were both co-opted. In October 2006 I became the webmaster of the parish website. And since September 2006 I have represented the council on the Orchard View reference Group, Orchard View is the last remaining part of the former Ham Green Hospital, and provides respite care, but North Bristol NHS Trust want to close it. I along with the rest of the group are trying to keep it open.

I ran as an independent, as in my view parish affairs are not relevant to party politics. So I could not declare my membership of UKIP, but in election leaflet I did include the following paragraph;

*"I know the NHS is in debt, but in my view asset stripping is NOT the solution. Better management might help, but while this government and previous Conservative governments continue to fund a corrupt Brussels bureaucracy with billions of our tax payers pounds every year; instead of taking care of the British citizens. The NHS will always be under funded."*

Easton-in-Gordano parish has two wards, Pill and St Georges, I was originally co-opted for the St Georges ward which has five members. In the elections I was a candidate for the Pill ward, the ward in which I live. Pill ward has ten members. There were twelve candidates, electors had ten votes.

Despite spending hours printing and delivering my election leaflet, I only just managed to get elected with 344 votes, my nearest rival who failed to be elected had 340 votes.



Since being elected I have joined the councils 'Finance and General Purposes committee, (perhaps being an accountant will be useful) and the Dock Liaison committee, and I am the councils representative for the Pill Youth Club and I am still on the Orchard View reference group. Which gives me more opportunities to network with the community.
